## Meditation Times during the Season of Lent.

In the course of our daily lives there are so many concerns and distractions, things to be done, work and preparation for tomorrow. The schedule of parents who have to balance the demands of time for work, care for children after school, and normal family life is often very full and leaves little time for reflection and relaxation. During the season of Lent, which begins on Ash Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March, we hope to introduce you to Christian Meditation time at St. Canice's Church. Each evening there will be an introduction time when the participants will be helped to relax and enter into a peaceful mode with the help of beautiful music from the Taize Community in Burgundy in France. Then the Meditation will help you to enter into a reflective experience based on a particular theme, eg. Trust, Desert, The All encompassing Love of God. This will be followed by the reading and reflection on a passage of Scripture. There will then be time for Intercession, prayers for the needs of the community, the world, and the requests for prayer we receive from the people.
