Dear Friends,

Let us not become complacent! Having seen the RTE Investigates programme on
the Covid 19 cases in our hospitals, I am on alert. I have never seen people so ill.
What generous and heroic care has been given by our care services. Let us beware.
This is a deadly virus. Of course you are looking forward to returning again to
Sunday Masses and I am too. However, please take your time coming back.

Stay at home if you are in any way vulnerable. The Sunday Mass obligation has
been suspended. You may continue to use the webcam or the radio to follow Mass.
It would be tragic if we were the cause of spreading the virus.

When you come to Church, please sanitize your hands and follow the directions
of the ushers, keep the social distance. At Communion time, please observe the
one way system. When the sign goes up that the number 50 has been reached, we
hope you will appreciate we are restricted by Govt .regulations, not to take in any
more people. During the week Mass is celebrated at 9.15am each day and the
weekend schedule is now restored. Regarding the collection-take care. We will not
be passing around any baskets to minimise the danger of spreading infection. Just
use the large bin situated in the porch for your Offerings and your Stations
Envelopes. Thank you for your generous support during these past weeks. It is
heartening to witness your generosity and your appreciation of your Parish's
service to the Community. Don't hesitate to come to the Parochial House if you
need anything –eg. Mass Cards or anniversaries.

May the Lord continue to bless us. Let us listen to his Word and spend some
quality time in silent prayer. He is our refuge and our strength. - Jim
