Posting letters

We are sorry that we have no Letter Box at the Parish Centre. With all the glass there is no way of installing a box. You are welcome to use the letterbox at the Parochial House or at the Curates' House. We also decided to install a letterbox inside the Church porch on the left hand side. It is secure with a strong lock and it is covered by the camera. Please use it for your donations. Be careful **not** to place envelopes containing offerings in the basket at the altar. I have rescued many envelopes left in by trusting, well-meaning parishioners. Unfortunately, not everyone visiting the Church is there for prayer, as we discovered recently when a candle shrine box at St. Therese's shrine was rifled. We observed the culprit on camera and he has been apprehended by the Gardai.

We will check the box on a daily basis - so have no fears.
