A note from Fr. Tom

In these very days, Pope Francis is in Iraq. It is a land that has had major upheavals. It is also the land where Abraham was born about 1900 BC. He is the "Father in Faith "for Judaism, Christianity and Islam. Fr Raheed Ganni is an Iraqi. He studied in the Irish College in Rome at the turn of the millennium and for a number of years. He was a frequent visitor to Ireland during those years. Returning to Mosul (the ancient city of Nineveh), he served the small but heroic Christian community. Extreme elements indicated their displeasure and threatened Fr. Raheed from the beginning. In spite of these threats, the young priest continued his ministry, fully aware of the danger to his life. One Sunday morning after Mass a Militia waylaid him and murdered him.

Fr. Raheed's ministry had cost him not less than everything.
