#### Alone- Supporting and Befriending the Elderly in their homes.

I have been a volunteer with the above service since 2008 and have been enriched by the people I have encountered during this time. The elderly of our Society have much wisdom to share, along with experience of life from which we can learn so much. They also possess the resources to have coped so well with what they encountered along life's journey. Being a volunteer asks a commitment of 1hour a week of our time to spend in the elderly person's home which isn't a lot but makes a difference. In 2017 Carlow/ Kilkenny Contact as it was called when I became a volunteer, merged with ALONE but for me people are still at the centre of the service. The elderly in their homes need to see more than ever, the friendly presence and face of the volunteer. Conversation with another human being is so important, phones have their place but the human contact is vital for our elderly peoples' mental health and wellbeing. Listening to the people I have visited has been a privilege for me over the years. Trust has grown among us and we have become friends. I feel welcomed into their homes and hearts..

Loneliness is part of everybody's life but more so if you are living alone, confined to your home for whatever reason, or have no immediate family, so a visit from an AlONE volunteer may be the only human contact, some of our elderly people have during the week. One person told me that she hadn't seen anybody since my vist the previous week. Hard to believe but that was her experience. Surely these people deserve more. Covid 19 was very difficult for the elderly because of lack of contact but restrictions are lifting, thank God. Let us all look out for elderly neighbours and maybe you could spare and hour a week to become a volunteer with ALONE – Máirín
