Winter Burglary Prevention – a message from the Gardai

As we approach the time of year when the clocks are set to go back, we are once again appealing to people to secure their homes and premises and to Lock Up and Light Up during the winter months.

Traditionally Burglaries increase by 20% over the winter months of October to March. Some simple methods can make your home and premises less vulnerable to Criminal Attack: Lighting around the house on a sensor or photocell, Lighting inside on timers, Natural Surveillance- trim shrubs down to 1m and trees up to 2m, Use Bogus Caller Cards, Close Curtains during hours of Darkness.
