Pope Francis – Synodality

It is already 10 years since the election of Pope Francis as Supreme Pastor of the Church -13^{th} March 2013.

It was amazing when the new Pope emerged on the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica to greet the people. He called everybody to pause in silence to spend a few moments to pray for him. Every day since I pray for him. What a great blessing we have received in this wonderful Pope. Pope Francis wrote an apostolic letter. – Evangelii Guadium – The Joy of the Gospel – setting out his programme, his first major policy statement. He wants to bring forward the teachings of Vatican Council II and tries to help us to appreciate our calling to live as the People of God. Cardinal Marc Ouellet said recently "the world needs a spiritual leader, a father in some way. And he has the figure of a father, close to the people, merciful, compassionate." As we give thanks for this prophet and holy man chosen to lead us, let us continue to pray for him. May the Spirit strengthen and support him as he cares for the people and the earth on which we live and need to care for lovingly. Last Monday evening at St. Kieran's College, Bishop Niall Coll gave a very interesting address on Synodality – what does it mean?

I enjoyed the presentation and the discussion. Next Monday the Bishop will speak again at St. Kieran's on this topic so important to Pope Francis.
