#### New Nuncio in Dublin

Pope Francis has appointed Argentinian, Archbishop Mariano Montemayor, as the new apostolic nuncio to Ireland. He will represent the Holy See to the Irish government and draw up shortlists of candidates to be appointed as bishops. The new nuncio is an experienced Vatican diplomat. He served as papal nuncio in the Democratic Republic of Congo from 2015 to 2018. In 2018 he was recalled to Rome after the President, Joseph Kabila, declared him 'unwelcome' because of his support for pro-democracy protests and his criticism of Congo's political leaders. He has recently served as nuncio in Colombia; he had previous postings in Ethiopia and Brazil and in 2008 he was appointed nuncio to Senegal, Cape Verde and Guinea-Bissau, along with serving as apostolic delegate to Mauritania.

## New App to share faith

A free app has been launched to encourage Christians to share their faith. The Isaiah 61 Movement - or i61m- was designed by Christians Against Poverty founder John Kirkby CBE and his team. The Redemptorists in Ireland have also launched a new digital evangelisation platform. 'The Preached Word' is a new mobile phone app hosting a team of 50 preachers, including new voices of Religious, both lay and ordained.
