St Mary's Cathedral Tour

This weekend sees the launch of an interactive tour of St Mary's Cathedral. By means of QR codes visitors can interact with and learn about the fascinating history of this wonderful building. Built by the people of Kilkenny in the 1840s it has a rich legacy of sacred art, design and prayer. The tour will be available year-round for a daily pass at a cost of €5. The tour, however, will be free of charge this Sunday 10th Sept. and the following Sunday 17th Sept. for the people of our Diocese and beyond. A second phase of the tour will also launch in the weeks ahead.

Water!

During this heatwave we are advised to drink plenty of water. It is important not to become dehydrated. We are all becoming more conscious of the damages from being exposed to the sunshine. They are advising me to wear a sunhat. Remember when we were young, we were exposed to the sun and often got sunburnt. The great relief came from a medication called Calamine lotion! So take plenty of care to wear head gear and drink plenty of water.

At the School Mass with the Loreto Students in St. Mary's Cathedral on Thursday, I was most impressed by the over 1000 students who filled the church. The music and singing was inspiring and beautiful. We reflected on the dangers of dehydration and of Spiritual Dehydration. All of us need some time for silence in our days – to allow ourselves come to an awareness of the presence of God. In the silence we can listen to his voice by reflecting on the Word of God in the Scriptures. We are nourished by the Bread of Life in the Eucharist. I was encouraging the students to come to Mass more often. So in short – to avoid Spiritual Dehydration we need to - in the SILENCE, LISTEN to God's Word and be nourished by the BREAD of LIFE in the Eucharist.

On Tuesday last I joined my friend Fr. Benny O'Shea, who was with me in the US recently, at the funeral in St. Mary's Abbey, Glencairn, near Lismore, Co. Waterford, of his aunt Sr. Agnes O'Shea from Windgap.

Sr. Agnes joined the Cistercians at the age of 21 and had spent 72 years as a member of the monastic Community. It was an amazing experience to celebrate with the Sisters and visiting monks and priests and her relatives and friends. The Cistercians give great time each day to the Silence, chanting the Office, listening to God's Word and celebrating the Eucharist. I am sure Sr. Agnes is continuing to pray for us from her new home in Paradise. —Fr Jim
