**Fr. Frank Brennan, SJ.,** will present a lecture "From Pope Francis to Pope Leo XVI: An Australian Perspective", in St Patrick's Parish Centre, Loughboy on Thurs 25<sup>th</sup> Sept. at 7.30 p.m. All are welcome. Frank Brennan is a Jesuit priest and Rector of Newman College at the University of Melbourne. He is a Distinguished Fellow of the PM Glynn Institute at Australian Catholic University, an Adjunct Professor at the Thomas More Law School at ACU and research professor at the Australian Centre for Christianity and Culture. He chaired the National Human Rights Consultation for the Rudd Government and was a member of the Turnbull Government's expert panel which conducted the Religious Freedom Review. The Morrison Government had appointed him to the Voice Co-Design Senior Advisory Group to help guide the Co-Design process to develop options for an Indigenous voice to government.
