Kilimanjaro Direct – Appeal for funds to buy a bus!

Kilimanjaro Direct was founded by Sheila Ryan in 2005. I became involved in the Charity in 2007. The aim of the Charity is to help alleviate poverty in the Kilimanjaro area of Tanzania, Africa. In 2010 a group of us, with the help of local volunteers constructed a nine Classroom School and Administration Block – the project was completed in 2012. During my visit in 2014 I became aware of an orphanage outside Moshi. The only facility they had for their education was a lean-to shed with planks of wood as seating and a broken down blackboard. These children could be accommodated in our school if they had transport. Having researched the cost, we now know that it is possible. I intend to return to Kilimanjaro in July 2017 and hopefully with the resources to purchase a suitable vehicle in the knowledge that the school will provide a trained driver. I am appealing for your financial support towards this very worthwhile project. I give you an absolute assurance that all contributions received will be applied to the project without any deductions or expenses.

I will be making an appeal at all Masses this week end and a collection will be taken up outside.
