Known only to God. Last weekend, our Organist, Mr Sean O'Neill and his nephew, John Britton invited Fr. Jim to accompany them to pray at the grave of their cousin, George Hayden, who died in the Great War on 22nd April, 1916, at the age of 21 years. George worked as a baker in Urlingford and enlisted at Clonmel in 1915. He is laid to rest at the military cemetery in Calais, France. Along the rows of identical tombstones the names of the dead are listed and some, with no names, have the inscription " Known only to God". Looking out on the beautiful fertile fields of Flanders in the Springtime where the blossoms are resplendant in the sunshine and the farmers till the fields, and the larks continue to sing, one wonders about the loss of life and the futility of war. When will we ever learn?
