Dear Parishioners

It has been a difficult few months for all our congregation in St. Canices. Thankfully, restrictions have eased and the green light has been given to open our Churches for public masses. Within the past week, Fr. Jim and Fr. Tom have been busy planning for the reopening. We have been required to establish a 'Covid Committee' and you will see that posters have been placed at the entrances to the Church. (All complaints to Aidan G Brennan!)

The Committee met last weekend and thanks to the very helpful advice and guidance of Dr. John Cuddihy we have prepared the Church for the congregation. The number of persons permitted to attend will be limited to 50.

In the restricted seating arrangements, every second row has been roped off. The pews in the centre can only accommodate two persons - unless they are members of the same family. The side aisle seating will only be able to accommodate one per seat - again, unless members of the same family. We will have a one way system in place for Holy Communion to avoid meeting other people. It will be a strange arrangement, but I am sure that we will get used to it in time. Last Monday evening we had a meeting of Eucharistic Ministers and Ministers of the Word to go through the new setup and within the next week we will be getting stewards to assist at Mass.
