Mary's Meals – Walk to Knock 2024

Mary's Meals, named in honour of Our Lady, feeds over 2.4 million children in 18 countries every day at their schools, using local produce, which is prepared by local volunteers at each school. This means the children come to school and are educated as well as fed, taking pressure off their families, many of whom are in dire poverty.

It costs just €22 to feed a child for a year, and administrative costs are kept to a minimum at 7 cent in the Euro. Starting on Wednesday 7th August, Irish volunteers will begin to walk to Knock, from a number of starting points around the country, and they are all due to arrive in Knock on 15th August, the Feast of the Assumption.

Two volunteers will begin at 9 a.m. from St John's Church Kilkenny via Castlecomer. Authorised collectors wearing distinctive blue t-shirts will be happy to receive your donations on the streets. Mary's Meals volunteers have Garda Permits for street collection on the 7th in Kilkenny.
